Instructions for outside client's to order Seattle Children's Dried Blood Spot Testing for Immunosuppressants

Dried Blood Spot (DBS) testing is now available for three immunosuppressants: Cyclosporine, Sirolimus, and Tacrolimus. The dried blood spots are collected by families or outside care providers and sent to Seattle Children's Chemistry Lab for testing.

Blood spot cards, requisitions, and postage-paidpreaddressed envelopes will be provided to you by Seattle Children's Laboratory. Please allow for <u>2 weeks</u> for materials to arrive.

Other collection items will need to be acquired by the outside client: lancets, alcohol swabs, sandwich bags, and band-aids.
