## Dried Blood Spot Testing for Immunosuppressants

**Dried Blood Spot (DBS) testing is now available for three immunosuppressants: Cyclosporine, Sirolimus, and Tacrolimus. The dried blood spots are collected by families or outside care providers and sent to Seattle Children's Chemistry Lab for testing.**

**Blood spot cards, requisitions, and postage-paid-preaddressed envelopes will be provided to you by Seattle Children's Laboratory.**

**Please allow for 2 weeks for materials to arrive.**

**Other collection items will need to be acquired by the outside client: lancets, alcohol swabs, sandwich bags, and band-aids.**
